




# MATERIAL PREPARATION



Only <b>PLASTIC BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS</b> which have a neck are recyclable. <b>NO OTHER PLASTIC CONTAINERS ARE ACCEPTED.</b>	Rinse containers and remove caps. Labels do not have to be removed.	The following items are <b>NOT</b> recyclable: Plastic bottle caps, butter or margarine tubs, cups or bowls, frozen food plates, motor oil containers, deli trays, styrofoam egg cartons, plastic bags, five-gallon buckets or ice cream tubs. <b>ONLY BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS WITH A NECK!</b>
<b>ALUMINUM AND STEEL</b> beverage and food cans are recyclable. Aluminum foil and pie tins are also accepted. Pie tins must be rinsed.	Remove all liquid and food residue. Labels do not have to be removed. Ends don't need to be removed; instead, stuff the ends inside the can. <b>PLEASE RINSE.</b>	Glass, plastic and metal containers are comingled, and may be mixed together for recycling.
<b>GLASS BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS ONLY</b>	Brown, clear and green food/beverage containers. Blue glass is also acceptable. Remove caps and lids. Labels do not need to be removed. <b>PLEASE RINSE.</b>	<b>No light bulbs, dishes, window panes, flower vases, dinnerware, drinking glasses, etc.!</b>
<b>MIXED PAPER</b> includes office paper, junk mail, newspaper, newspaper inserts and flyers, cereal boxes, magazines, catalogs, phone books, etc.	Try storing all your paper in a brown grocery bag. You can then throw the bag and its contents into the "paper" bin.	<b>Do not put plastic bags with your mixed paper! No waxed milk cartons, frozen food containers, styrofoam egg cartons, plastic wrappers, paper napkins, plates or cups.</b> No dog/cat food bags are accepted because they are made for wet-strength! <b>NO WET OR DIRTY PAPER.</b>
<b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b> boxes such as packing and shipping boxes. <b>FLATTEN ALL BOXES</b>	Open ends and flatten boxes.  Place all corrugated boxes in the bin marked "cardboard" recycling.  <b>NOTHING ELSE GOES IN THIS BIN!</b>	<b>WE DO NOT RECYCLE STYROFOAM OF ANY TYPE. NO PIZZA BOXES, NO WET OR DIRTY CARDBOARD</b>

**NOTE: The Henderson County Solid Waste Division operates a bag for bag program. A bag of trash can be taken to the transfer station at no charge with an equivalent amount of recyclables.**

Please place each item in the appropriately marked bin. Bins are marked:

**CARDBOARD** for corrugated boxes. Please **flatten** and place in opening of bin.

**PAPER** for newspaper and mixed paper. Place in same bin. No more separating these!

**CONTAINERS** for glass, plastic and cans. All plastic bottles, jars and jugs, all glass bottles and jars, PLUS, all aluminum and steel cans may be placed in this bin.
